I appreciate that a few clubs have been asking about current insurance arrangements. As previously stated, CNSW and its members continue to have the benefit of the insurances which were put in place at the start of 2020 by Cycling Australia and our insurer has provided to us an updated endorsement which clarifies that this is the case (see attached).

As in previous years, these arrangements require all participants in a race or event conducted by CNSW or a CNSW club to be CNSW members. For this reason, CNSW has prepared the attached membership form which can be signed by any cyclist who is not registered with CNSW but wishes to participate at an event or race conducted by CNSW or a CNSW club. The form provides membership in CNSW for the rest of calendar year 2020. Once signed and a copy sent to CNSW, we will update our records and the relevant cyclist may participate in all events and races conducted by CNSW or a CNSW club this year.
